### Criminal case for foreign citizen and court interpreter

(外国人刑事事件と法廷通訳)

The Court interpreter plays an important role during criminal cases in which the defender is a foreign citizen who needs the assistance of an interpreter. Criminal cases that involve foreign citizens have been steadily rising in recent years.

However there is a lack of interpreter candidates in some languages. Therefore, the court is recruiting interpreter candidates. If an interpreter candidate who does not have enough experience is appointed as a court interpreter, a training course is available so that he or she will be able to work as a court interpreter appropriately.



- \* Disposal method
  - 1. Make sure the trays are clean.
  - 2. Dry the trays well.
  - 3. Dispose of the trays in recycling bags.

#### From April 1st. More items. (4月1日から資源ごみの収集品目が増えます)

Juice and Milk cartons ( 500ml,1,000ml) the cartons with white interiors will be recycled starting on April 1st.

Please dispose these cartons at the collection site on the collection day.

- \* Disposal method
- 1. Wash the carton..
- 2.Cut it out and dry well.
- 3. Remove any attached plastic.
- 4. Tie the paper cartons together, put them in a clear bag and dispose at the collection site.

Note: Paper cartons with silver interior and any cartons that are not 500ml or 1,000ml are general rubbish.

Supermarkets also have recycle bags for the foam trays and Juice and Milk cartons.
